4. Ending (l. 69–79)

Aspects important to Lady Bracknell

- „Society“ (l. 63)
e.g.: „chin a little higher“ (l. 56f.)
- „age of surfaces“ (l. 45)
- „fortune“ (l. 38)
- Lady Bracknell is not in favour of long engagements (l. 77)
- Lady Bracknell is not in favour of mercenary marriages (l. 65; this is a contradiction; cf. l. 38)
- appearance (l. 46ff.)
